# Process and Timeline

## **December 2022**

- Technical leads introduce concept to Stakeholder Advisory Committee (SAC) and share potential practices for each land sector

## **December 2022 through March 2023**

- Technical leads contact subject matter experts\* to discuss and compile potential practices and metrics

## **February through March 2023**

- Forestry and Ag SAC subcommittees convene to discuss potential practices and metrics

## **April 2023**

- SAC reviews draft practices and metrics document produced by technical teams and compares and contrasts concepts proposed by SAC subcommittees with practices and metrics proposed by technical teams
- Facilitators share SAC review of practices and metrics document with technical leads to discuss SAC feedback and consider incorporating suggested edits from SAC
- SAC continues to refine its comments and recommendations through its subcommittees and as a larger committee
- Facilitators add step to process – reaching out to 40 individuals\* for additional review of draft practices and metrics document – conduct one-on-one interviews as well as solicit written feedback

## **May through July 2023**

- SAC refines its edits and comments on practices and metrics document

## **August 2023**

- INR produces draft final report on entire project to Oregon Global Warming Commission
- SAC reviews draft final report to Oregon Global Warming Commission

## **September 15, 2023**

- INR finalizes report to Oregon Global Warming Commission
  - Report describes input from technical teams, SAC, and external review conducted by facilitators
